Rachel Quarry

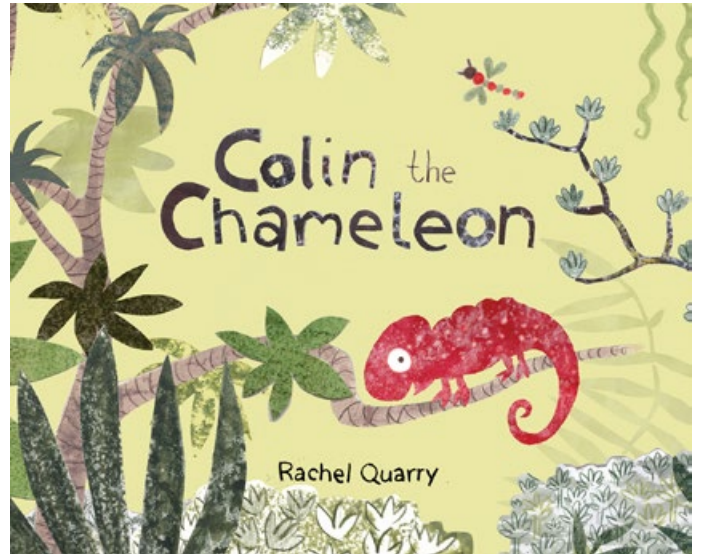
At first, Colin is dismayed by his differences—but eventually he learns just how valuable his quirks can be.
